- Iowa Code Enforcement Officer of the Year – awarded for the most outstanding code enforcement work by an individual for in the past year.
- Iowa Code Enforcement Department of the Year – awarded for the most outstanding code enforcement work by a department for the past year.
- Creative Ideas in Code Enforcement Award – awarded for the best new and creative ways to solve problems we face in Code Enforcement during the past year (this one can be for an individual or for a whole department).

*The winners of these awards will receive a sponsorship for one (1) of the following:

- lowACE 1-year membership and an lowACE Conference registration cost for one person
- AACE Conference registration cost for one person
- ICC Conference registration cost for one person

**Winners of these awards will be announced at the lowACE conference in November.

The Awards Program nominations can be made by anyone with direct knowledge of code enforcement accomplishments including code officers, supervisors, city staff, elected officials, citizens, or you may even nominate yourself or your department.

- Municipality or Employer
- Which award you are nominating the individual or department for
- Short but detailed statement about why this individual or department is deserving of the award along with any supporting documentation.

- Name of the person(s) nominating

lowACE Special Recognition Program - Nominations

Iowa Association of Code Enforcement is offering a special recognition program in 2025. The following special recognitions being given to all who qualify:

- Career Service Recognition – awarded to all nominees who have dedicated ten or more years of service in the code enforcement profession and are within one year of retirement or retired.
- Board of Directors Service Recognition – awarded to any Board of Directors who have completed their service to the lowACE Board during the previous calendar year.

All those being recognized with receive a certificate or plaque and be recognized at the in-person training conference.

The Career Service Recognition nominations can be made by anyone with direct knowledge of code enforcement accomplishments including supervisors, city staff, elected officials, citizens, or you may nominate yourself. Board of Directors Service Recognition will be automatically submitted by the Board.
